Urgench State University named after Al-Khorezmiy (UrSU) was founded by the decree #356 of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on February 28, 1992 on the base of Khorezm Pedagogical State Institute. (It was established in 1935) Today Urgench State University is the leading higher educational institution in Khorezm region of Uzbekistan. We offer 45 Bachelor's Degree and 14 Master's Degree and 10 PhD programs regarding to the different areas of science and technology, engineering, pedagogy, physical training, economics, arts, etc. The university consists of 9 faculties and 30 departments. Total number of students is 6828. About 400 full – time and more than 50 short - time professors and lecturers work at Urgench State University. The university has 7 main buildings, 4 student dormitories, 2 informational resource centers, many sport clubs and other opportunities for student's entertainments. Each year approximately 1500 students graduate from the university. The majority of them are hired by the leading local companies, governmental and non-governmental organizations. All students and teaching staff are provided by the rapid and free Internet access. There are about 1000 personal computers, 34 computer classes at UrSU.
